






Traffic Advisory

Unscheduled road repairs along a small stretch of the northbound exit roadway is causing the closure of the south entrance at 182nd St at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and is expected to create additional congestion on the airport drives.

Due to the road repairs, travelers are asked to be aware of increased time to travel through the airport drives and are encouraged to use alternative options for pickup and dropoff of passengers. Including:

- Use public transportation such as Sound Transit's Link Light Rail, rideshares, courtesy vehicles or airporters.
- Pickup or drop off passengers one stop away at the Tukwila or Angle Lake Light Rail stations or use the Sound Transit Drop off and Pick up location at 176th St. and International Boulevard.
- Use the airport garage to pickup and drop off to avoid the drive and exiting will avoid the construction location.
- For pickups during the evening rush period, Think Opposite – use the upper/Departure drive at night to avoid traffic.
- Overheight vehicles take the departures drive to South Garage entrance
