

RESOLUTION NO. 3404

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle Declaring Certain Personal Property Surplus for Port District Purposes and further declaring that said property should be Sold or disposed of as provided by statute.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has owned the personal property described as Washington Crane, Serial No. 5294, Port of Seattle No. 19, estimated value at \$75,000; and

WHEREAS, said property is no longer needed for its intended purpose, or other purposes of the Port; and

WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof adopted by a vote of the people of said district; and


WHEREAS, the Washington Port of Pasco has approved purchase of Port of Seattle Crane 19 to replace an older crane at Pasco. Port sale of the Crane 19 to the Port of Pasco would respond to their need for a better crane; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.33 of the Revised Code of Washington provides that the Port may “sell, transfer, exchange, lease or otherwise dispose of any property...the state or any municipality or any political subdivision thereof...on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon...”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the Washington Crane, Serial No. 5294, Port of Seattle No. 19, is no longer needed for district purposes and that it is in the best interest of said district that said property be sold to the Washington Port of Pasco for \$75,000; and




