

RESOLUTION NO. 3494

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle Declaring Certain Personal Property Surplus for Port of Seattle Purposes and Authorizing its Sale, Transfer or Disposal: Des Moines Way Nursery Mature Plants and Japanese Garden Fixtures and Plants.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle owns the personal property described below, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.33 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) provides that the Port may “sell, transfer, exchange, lease or otherwise dispose of any property ... to the state or any municipality or any political subdivision thereof ... on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon...”, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. The following described personal property is no longer needed for Port purposes and that it is in the best interest of the Port that said personal property be declared surplus and sold, transferred or disposed of:




Section 2. The Director of Accounting and Procurement Services is authorized to take all necessary steps to arrange for the sale, transfer or other disposal of said personal property and to execute all documents necessary to accomplish such disposal in accordance with state law, including transfer of the property pursuant to the Intergovernmental Disposition of Property Act, Chapter 39.33 RCW.




