

## RESOLUTION NO. 3495

**A RESOLUTION** of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle  
Declaring Certain Personal Property Surplus for Port  
of Seattle Purposes and Authorizing its Sale,  
Transfer or Disposal: Miscellaneous Seaport Rolling  
Stock.

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Seattle owns the personal property described below; and

**WHEREAS**, said property is no longer needed for use, or other purposes of the Port, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle  
that:

Section 1. The following described property is no longer needed for Port purposes and  
that it is in the best interest of the Port that said property be declared surplus and sold, transferred  
or disposed of:


	<u>Estimated Resale Value</u>

Section 2. The Director of Accounting and Procurement Services is authorized to take  
all necessary steps to arrange for the sale, transfer or disposal of said property and to execute all  
documents necessary to accomplish disposal in accordance with state law.

Section 3. Any acts of the Director of Accounting and Procurement Services made  
consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this Resolution cited are hereby  
ratified and confirmed.
