

RESOLUTION NO. 3503

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle adopting a supplemental final budget of the Port of Seattle for the year 2003; modifying the operating document to reflect the establishment of a new operating division.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle Commission, on the 26th day of November, 2002, adopted a final budget of the Port of Seattle for the year 2003; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said supplemental budget was held in the office of the Port Commission, pursuant to notice duly given, in the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington, on the 25th day of March 2002, at 1:00 p.m.; and


WHEREAS, all parties present were afforded full opportunity to present objections to the supplemental budget, and the Port Commission being duly advised in the premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the preliminary budget of the Port of Seattle for the year 2003, as presented at the aforementioned hearing, is hereby adopted as the supplement to the final budget of the Port of Seattle for the Year 2003;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the amount of taxes to be levied by the Port of Seattle on the current assessment rolls to provide for payment of bond redemption and interest on

the Port of Seattle General Obligation Bonds, for future expenditures for harbor acquisitions and capital improvements and for such general purposes allowed by law which the Port deems necessary be set and deposited will not change from the amount put forth to the King County Assessor in December of 2002.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle at a regular meeting held this 8th of April, 2003, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal of the Commission.



2. The Port Commission will meet on March 25, 2003 at the hour of 1:00 p.m. at Sea-Tac International Airport large auditorium, located at 17801 Pacific Highway South, Seattle, Washington, for the purpose of a public hearing on the supplemental budget, which time any person may appear and present comments on the supplemental budget; and

3. Immediately after the public hearing, the Port Commission will be requested to adopt by resolution the 2003 supplemental budget.
