

RESOLUTION NO. 3138

RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring a commitment to maintaining the Port's role as a community leader in recycling and waste minimization.

WHEREAS, The Port of Seattle has been recycling successfully for several years; and

WHEREAS, 50% of all waste at Pier 66 was recycled in 1992, significantly reducing disposal costs and contributing to the preservation of our environment; and

WHEREAS, Sea-Tac International Airport is implementing a comprehensive recycling program and is designated by the Airports Council International (ACI) and the Air Transport Association (ATA) as the national model for airport recycling;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1: The Port of Seattle's policy is to create a partnership between economy and ecology in achieving our organizational goals. We are fully committed to the principles of reducing, reusing and recycling waste materials in all offices and facilities within the Port of Seattle.

Section 2: We will commit, within our existing operational, financial, and purchasing policies, to buy supplies and equipment made from recycled materials with post-consumer content.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 9th day of March, 1993, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the Seal of the Commission duly affixed.
