NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:





Section 1. The following described property is no longer needed for district purposes and that it is in the best interest of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of:

Section 2. The Manager, Purchasing is authorized to take all necessary steps to arrange for the sale of said property to Stevedoring Services of America and to execute all documents necessary therefore, or, in the alternative to accomplish disposal in accordance with state law.
