

RESOLUTION NO. 3044

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle recognizing five (5) years of successful cooperative dispute resolution and negotiation between the Port of Seattle and the communities of Queen Anne and Magnolia.

WHEREAS, the Terminal 91 Short Fill Redevelopment Agreement between the communities of Queen Anne and Magnolia and the Port Commission was signed in 1983, resolving disputes regarding the "short fill" redevelopment of Terminal 91, establishing a framework for resolving future issues, and setting forth a new charter for the Neighbors Advisory Committee (NAC).


WHEREAS, the purpose of NAC is to foster a spirit of good will between the Port and the residents of Magnolia and Queen Anne, and to bear prime oversight responsibility for monitoring the Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Port, the Magnolia Community Club and the Queen Anne Community Council have cooperated in fulfilling the letter and the spirit of the Terminal 91 Short Fill Redevelopment Agreement.

WHEREAS, the past five (5) years of successful problem solving, and successful future negotiations, are due to the good faith efforts of all parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Port Commission extends their appreciation to the Queen Anne Community Council and the Magnolia Community Club for their participation and continuing efforts.
