

RESOLUTION NO. 3057

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring personal property surplus for Port District purposes and further declaring that said property should be sold or disposed of as provided by statute.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has owned the personal property described below; and

WHEREAS, said property is neither used nor needed for its intended purpose or other purposes of the Port; and

WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof, adopted by a vote of the people of said district;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the following described property is no longer needed for district purposes and that it is in the best interest of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of:
