WHEREAS, Bob Graham represented many other Washington ports for many years and was instrumental in the creation of the Washington Public Ports Association; and


WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle, the community and the State of Washington have suffered the loss of a distinguished, dedicated civic leader; and
