

RESOLUTION NO. 3091

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle expressing support for the creation of Living Memorial Plaza dedicated to all former U.S. Prisoners-Of-War and service members listed as Missing-In-Action at Washington Memorial Park.

WHEREAS, former Prisoners-Of-War (POW) and those still listed as Missing-In-Action (MIA) have made great personal sacrifices for the ideals for which our nation stands;


WHEREAS, a ground-breaking ceremony will be held on September 21, 1991 adjacent to Seattle-Tacoma International Airport at Washington Memorial Park for construction of a POW/MIA Living Memorial Plaza;

WHEREAS, the Living Memorial Plaza will serve as a symbol of hope and tribute to former POWs and existing MIAs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission acknowledges the contributions and sacrifices of POWs and MIAs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Port of Seattle, as a neighbor of Washington Memorial Park, recognizes the appropriateness of a Living Memorial Plaza for POWs and MIAs.
