

RESOLUTION NO. 3100

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle ratifying application to and authorizing acceptance of funding assistance from the National Endowment for the Arts for The Pine Street Corridor Study.

WHEREAS, the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle has approved The Pine Street Corridor Study as a part of the Port's Central Waterfront Project; and,

WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts, through its authorizing legislation, can provide project grants to organizations in support of "projects that advance design practice, research, theory, and communication. Examples of activities that may be funded in this category include...Proposing new solutions for linking urban centers to waterfront resources;" and,

WHEREAS, the Port Commission considers the coordinated study of The Pine Street Corridor will be a positive, innovative step in linking The Pike Place Public Market to the Central Waterfront;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

1. That any funding assistance so received be used in study of The Pine Street Corridor.
2. That the Chief Executive Officer's formal application to the National Endowment for the Arts for funding assistance be ratified.
3. That the Chief Executive Officer be authorized to accept funding assistance in the form of a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts.
4. The Grant shall be attached to this resolution upon execution and by this reference incorporated herein as Attachment "A."

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle at a regular meeting held January 28, 1992 and duly authenticated in open session with the signature of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the Seal of the Commission duly affixed.
