

**RESOLUTION 3103, As amended**

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle expressing concern that United Airlines is eliminating direct service to Hong Kong from Seattle and requesting that United Airlines reconsider its decision.

WHEREAS, United Airlines is a valued partner with the Port of Seattle, and;

WHEREAS, United Airlines has announced that it will eliminate its direct service from Seattle to Hong Kong, and;

WHEREAS, termination of direct service to Hong Kong by United Airlines will eliminate approximately 150 Seattle-based jobs and an estimated payroll of over \$3,000,000 annually in the Pacific Northwest, and;

WHEREAS, elimination of this service will have a significant impact on United Airlines' international presence in the Pacific Northwest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Port of Seattle Commission urges United Airlines to reconsider its decision to end direct service from Seattle to Hong Kong and the Port Commission urges continuation of direct service as being in the best interests of the airline, its Seattle-based employees and the Pacific Northwest.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 10th day of March, 1992, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal of the Commission.
