

RESOLUTION NO. 2961

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring personal property surplus for Port District purposes and further declaring that said property should be sold or disposed of as provided by statute.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has owned the personal property described below; and

WHEREAS, said property is neither used nor needed for its intended purpose or other purposes of the Port; and


WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof, adopted by the vote of the people of said district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the following described property is no longer needed for district purposes, and that it is in the best interest of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of:

Thirteen (13) Clark 512 Straddle Carriers  
Nos. 15, 17, 19, 21, 23, 28, 32, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that four (4) of the above straddle carriers Nos. 35, 36, 37, and 38 be transferred to Matson Terminals, Inc., in accordance with provisions of Matson's lease with the Port

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 23rd day of April, 1985, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the Seal of the Commission duly affixed.
