SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed to file said schedules with the Federal Maritime Commission.

(8) ALL NECESSARY SERVICES REQUIRED OR REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH CARGO STORED UNDER THIS ITEM WILL BE PERFORMED BY THE TERMINAL OPERATER UNDER RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS SPECIFIED IN THIS TARIFF.

SPACE

(C) STORAGE PROVISIONS APPLY ONLY ON CARGO PRIOR TO OR SUBSEQUENT TO MOVEMENT OVER A PORT OF SEATTLE MARINE TERMINAL AND CARRIAGE BY VESSELS.

RENTAL

(D) No cancellation of rental agreements entered into under this item will be permitted on less than 15 days notice. A full month's charge will be made for the month in which the agreement is cancelled or the area vacated.

NOTE: THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ITEM WILL NOT BE GRANTED IN TRANSIT SHEDS WHEN SUCH FACILITY IS ACTIVELY BEING USED TO LOAD AND DISCHARGE VESSELS.

Real estate may be leased for purposes other than cargo storage for periods up to 90 days at a rental figure of leight tenths of one percent per month based on the appraised value of the property involved.
