

RESOLUTION NO. 2683

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as  
follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt  
rules, regulations, and charges shown in:



SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed  
to file said schedules with the Federal Maritime Commission.

NOTE A - RATES ON CARGO REQUIRING REFRIGERATION WHICH MOVES THROUGH PORT OF SEATTLE-OWNED REFRIGERATION VAN-TYPE BOXES, OR REFRIGERATION LOCKERS, ARE SUBJECT TO AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF \$4.80 PER 2,000 LBS. OR \$5.29 PER 1,000 KILOS, EXCEPT UNITIZED CARGO AS DEFINED IN ITEM 10020 IS SUBJECT TO CHARGE OF \$3.20 PER 2,000 LBS. OR \$3.53 PER 1,000 KILOS, WHICH ACCRUES TO REFRIGERATION FACILITY.

NOTE B - RATES ON CARGO WHICH IS ACCUMULATED AT AND MOVED THROUGH THE PORT OF SEATTLE-OPERATED FRUIT COLD STORAGE WAREHOUSES ARE SUBJECT TO AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF \$2.75 PER 2,000 LBS. OR \$3.03 PER 1,000 KILOS, WHICH ACCRUES TO COLD STORAGE FACILITY.

■ CHARGE IS \$1.50 PER 2,000 LBS. OR \$1.65 PER 1,000 KILOS WHEN QUANTITY PER VESSEL VOYAGE EXCEEDS 100,000 CARTONS OR 4,000,000 LBS.
