rules, regulations, and charges shown in:



SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed  
to file said schedule with the Federal Maritime Commission.

RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO TEMPORARY NON-PREFERENTIAL ASSIGNMENT	ITEM NO.
<p>AT PORT OF SEATTLE TERMINALS, WHEN THE PORT DOES NOT PROVIDE ANY SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE RECEIPT, DELIVERY, CHECKING, CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL OF CARGO, THE PORT OF SEATTLE, ON SPACE-AVAILABLE BASIS, MAY GRANT PARTICIPANTS NAMED IN THIS TARIFF TEMPORARY NON-PREFERENTIAL ASSIGNMENT OF WHARF AREAS AND PRIVILEGES: (A) TO MOOR VESSELS OWNED OR OPERATED BY ASSIGNEE OR OTHER VESSELS WHICH MAY BE ASSIGNED BY THE PORT TO SUCH WHARF AREAS; (B) TO ASSEMBLE AND DISTRIBUTE MERCHANDISE AND CARGOES OF, OR FOR, SUCH VESSELS; AND (C) TO PERFORM SUCH OTHER RELATED ACTIVITIES IN TRANSITING CARGO AS MAY BE NECESSARY.</p> <p>ASSIGNEES AND VESSELS, THEIR OWNERS OR AGENTS, ARE SUBJECT TO THE RATES, CHARGES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS OF PORT OF SEATTLE TARIFFS.</p> <p>THE REMOVAL OF DUNNAGE AND ORDINARY SWEEPING AND CLEANING TO MAINTAIN THE WHARF AREA IN SAFE AND ORDERLY CONDITION IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ASSIGNEE.</p> <p>THE PORT WILL MAINTAIN BERTH, WHARF, BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES, WILL SUPPLY UTILITIES, EXCEPT UTILITIES REQUIRED BY VESSELS, AND WILL MAINTAIN AND FUEL PORT-OWNED CRANES AND CARGO HANDLING EQUIPMENT. <u>EXCEPTION</u> - ELECTRICITY IS NOT INCLUDED. A SEPARATE INVOICE WILL BE ISSUED FOR ACTUAL POWER USAGE AT RATES NAMED IN ITEMS 20010 AND 20015, OR AT ACTUAL COST WHEN SEPARATELY METERED. <b>▲ ■</b> FRESH WATER WILL BE CHARGED AT \$15.00 FOR FIRST 100 CUBIC FEET OR FRACTION THEREOF, ONLY WHEN ASSIGNEE PROVIDES HOSE AND LABOR, AND SUBJECT TO ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF ITEM 20030.</p> <p>VESSEL RESERVATIONS AND ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE ARRANGED BY THE PORT OF SEATTLE.
