

RESOLUTION NO. 2716

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle
modifying certain rates, rules, and regulations
in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 2-F, F.M.C.-T No. 3

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as
follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt
rules, regulations, and charges shown in:



rules, regulations, and charges to take effect on the date thereon.

SECTION 2. All rules, regulations, and charges conflicting with
the provisions of the above-listed pages in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 2-F,
F.M.C.-T No. 3, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed
to file said schedule with the Federal Maritime Commission.

CONTAINERIZED CARGO AND CONTAINERS, EMPTY, AS DEFINED HEREIN:

40070

(A) WHEN VESSEL FREIGHT CHARGES ARE ASSESSED THAT ARE BASED ON OUTSIDE MEASUREMENT OF CONTAINER OR GROSS WEIGHT OF CONTAINER, APPLY CARGO, N. O. S., SECTION 8, ITEM 80050.

(B) WHEN FREIGHT CHARGES ARE ASSESSED ON CONTAINER CONTENTS OR WHEN EMPTY CONTAINERS ARE SHIPPED FREIGHT FREE, APPLY UNIT RATES AS PER SCHEDULE BELOW, SUBJECT TO NOTE 1, 2 & 3:

NOTE 1. UNIT CONTAINER RATES APPLY ON ALL CONTAINERS DISCHARGED OR LOADED BETWEEN VESSELS (DEFINED ITEM 10050) OR BETWEEN VESSEL AND INLAND CARRIER (DEFINED ITEM 10070) OR BETWEEN VESSEL AND TERMINAL, SUBJECT TO EXCEPTION BELOW.

(X) ⚡ NOTE 2. ONLY INBOUND SERVICE AND FACILITIES CHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED ON EMPTY CONTAINERS TRANSSHIPPED AT THE SAME TERMINAL, BETWEEN OCEAN VESSELS OF THE SAME CARRIER, OPERATING IN TWO SEPERATE TRADE ROUTES AS DEFINED IN ITEM 10080.

NOTE 3. INCLUDES CHARGE FOR WEIGHING. NOT SUBJECT TO ITEM 20090.

EXCEPTION: CONTAINERS MADE EMPTY OR LOADED WITH CARGO ON THE TERMINAL FOR VESSEL CONVENIENCE ARE ASSESSED SERVICE AND FACILITIES CHARGE, AS NAMED IN THIS ITEM, PLUS LABOR CHARGES FOR CHECKERS PER ITEM 20160.
