SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed to file said schedule with the Federal Maritime Commission.

- NOTE C Unitized, as defined in Item 10020, PALLETIZED AND SHRINK WRAPPED CARGO, IS SUBJECT to a charge of \$2.70 per 2,000 lbs. or \$2.98 per 1,000 Kilos, which accrues to the refrigeration facility.
