and







WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan for improvement or modification thereof, adopted by the vote of the people of said district;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Port Commissioners of the Port of Seattle that the property described below is no longer needed for district purposes, and that it is in the best interest of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of as provided by statutes.

1. Large steel hulled, AJ type barge, Terminal 115
2. Superstructure of a large vessel, located on a pier at the property, Terminal 115.
