

RESOLUTION NO. 2752

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring personal property surplus for Port District purposes and further declaring that said property should be sold or disposed of in a reasonable manner.


WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has owned the personal property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, said property is neither used nor needed for its intended purpose or other purposes of the Port; and

WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof, adopted by the vote of the people of said district;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein is no longer needed for district purposes, and that it is in the best interests of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of as provided by statute.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 31st day of October, 1978 and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting and the seal of the Commission duly affixed.
