

RESOLUTION NO. 2600

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring 50,000 gallon water tank located at Terminal 20 surplus for Port District purposes and further declaring that said property should be sold or disposed of in a reasonable manner.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has owned the property described below:

50,000 gallon water tank with 2 - 8" and 2 - 2½" outlets, located immediately south of Transit Shed No. 3 at Terminal 20; and

WHEREAS, due to modifications in the operation of the Port and changes in the needs and requirements of the Port, said property is neither used nor needed for its intended purpose or other purposes of the Port; and

WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof, adopted by the vote of the people of said district:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Seattle that the property described above is no longer needed for district purposes, and that it is in the best interests of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of as provided by statute.
