

RESOLUTION NO. 2640

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle amending Salary and Benefit Resolution No. 2614 to provide shift differentials for employees in Marine Terminals positions required to work a night shift in conjunction with I.L.W.U. personnel working under the P.M.A. agreements; and, to define Swing Shift and Graveyard Shift by shift ending times.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:






Section V., Subsection C.2. of Resolution No. 2614, adopted December 19, 1975, is hereby amended retroactive to August 1, 1976 as follows (additions are in italics; deletions are crossed out within brackets):

Section V. ADMINISTRATION OF PAY PRACTICES

C. Extra Compensation:

2. For shift differential: Providing that they work a fixed, nonrotating work schedule, employees in the following classifications and their temporary substitutes shall receive a shift differential of 7.5% over their regular salary when required to work Swing Shift and 10% over their regular salary when required to work Graveyard Shift: Maintenance Shift Coordinators at the airport, Computer Operators, Keypunch Operators, Data Control Technicians, Waste Plant Operators, [~~and positions in the Word Processing Center~~] *Word Processing Center positions, and also Marine Terminals positions set up to work the night shift in conjunction with I.L.W.U. personnel working under the P.M.A. agreements. Swing Shift shall be a full time regularly scheduled work shift which ends between 10:30 p.m. and 2:00 a.m.; Graveyard Shift shall be a full time regularly scheduled work shift which ends later than 2:00 a.m. Application of shift differential pay is limited to the positions and the conditions stated herein.*

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 10th day of August, 1976, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting and the Seal of the Commission.
