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RESOLUTION NO.5

A RESOLUTION, making, determining and deciding the amount of taxes to be levied upon the current assessment rolls to provide the necessary expenses of the Port of Seattle, up to and including the 31st day of December, 1912.

WHEREAS, the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle on the 22nd day of September, 1911, adopted an estimate for the Port of Seattle from September 5, 1911 to January 1, 1913, in detail as required by law, and thereafter made publication of the same and gave notice of the 25th day of September, 1911 as the date that any tax payers might appear to be heard in favor of or against any items shown in estimate and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing of said estimate was held in the office of the Port Commission in compliance with said notice in Seattle, King County, Washington, on the 29th day of September, 1911, at 2:00 P.M., when and where tax payers in attendance at said meeting were heard in favor or against the items in said proposed tax levy; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle:

Section 1. That the following be, and hereby is made, determined and decided to be the budget of the expense of the Port of Seattle, from the 5th day of September, 1911 to the first day of January, 1913, to-wit:
