A RESOLUTION Directing the publication of report prepared under its direction, relating to the work of the Commission.

Be it resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That a report descriptive of comprehensive scheme and projects of development and containing instructions to voters, and a map be printed in such quantity -- not less than 25,000 copies -- as may be necessary for its general distribution among the voters of the District.
