## RESOLUTION NUMBER 22.

A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE FIXING THE ORDER IN WHICH THE DIFFERENT PROPOSITIONS VOTED UPON BY THE PROPLE WITHIN SAID PORT DISTRICT AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD MARCH 5, 1912, WILL BE TAKEN UP.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

That the Port Commission shall proceed without delay to take up the different propositions voted upon by the people in said port district at the special election held March 5, 1912, in the order in which such propositions appeared on the official ballot; and that said Port Commission shall proceed with the different improvements designated in the propositions so voted upon in the above named order.
