## RESOLUTION NO. 25.

A RESOLUTION Accepting the resignation of R.H. Thomson as Chief Engineer, and appointing Paul P. Whithem Acting Chief Engineer and fixing compensation.

Be it resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the resignation of R.H. Thomson as Chief Engineer to the Port Commission be accepted to take effect March 31, 1912, and that Principal Assistant Engineer, Paul P. Whitham, be appointed Acting Chief Engineer, with a salary of \$250 per month until a successor to Mr. Thomson has been appointed.

Section 2. That in severing connection with Mr. Thomson, the Port Commission does so with the same high estimate of his character, ability, and broad training that led it to confer the appointment upon him in the first place, and that it hopes that his services will be available in a consulting capacity for future assistance in the Commission's work.
