A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port
of Seattle in remembrance of
William J. Rogers, Jr.

WHEREAS, the death on Friday, September 15, 1972, of
Mr. William J. Rogers, Jr., a distinguished member of the Puget
Sound Steamship Operators Association, brought to a close a long and
outstanding career in public and private service, and

WHEREAS, the people of King County, the City of Seattle, and
the steamship industry have lost the services of a diligent and dedicated
member of the maritime community, and

WHEREAS, the members of the Port Commission and staff of
the Port of Seattle all have had the highest personal regard for William J.
Rogers, Jr., and appreciated the time and energy he gave for the advance-
ment and improvement of shipping on Puget Sound waters,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the undersigned
Commissioners, in behalf of the Port of Seattle, extend their sincere
condolences to the surviving members of the family, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be included

Puget Sound Steamship Operators Association.
