PER VESSEL ♦ 10¢ PER FOOT OF REGISTERED LENGTH EXCEPT DURING SEASON WHEN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON HAS AUTHORIZED AREA 6 OPEN FOR COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHING THEN 5¢ PER FOOT. MINIMUM CHARGE: \$1.00 MONTHLY FISHING VESSELS ONLY DURING SEASON WHEN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON HAS AUTHORIZED THAT AREA 6 IN PUGET SOUND IS OPEN FOR COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHING AND ONLY WHEN ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN FISHING. PER VESSEL GILLNET - SAME AS AT FISHERMEN'S TERMINAL PURSE SEINER - SEE ITEM 1070 PARIENT OF THIS HONTHLE RATE AILL ENTITLE VESSEL TO MOOR AT CITHER LISHERMEN'S TERMINAL OR SHILSHOLE. FISHING AND COMMERCIAL VESSEL REGISTRATION AND PROCEDURES 1. ALL FISHING AND COMMERCIAL VESSELS REMAINING FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN 24 HOURS, WHETHER MOORDED OR ANCHORED, MUST BE REGISTERED BY OWNER OR OPERATORS, AS SUON AS POSSIBLE AFTER ARRIVAL, AT THE REGISTRATION BOX NEAR THE MARINA OFFICE. VESSELS WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE CHARGES OUTLINED IN ITEM 1155 DURING COMMERCIAL FISHING SEASON AND ITEM 1160 AT OTHER TIMES. 2. ALL MOORAGE CHARGES MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO DEPARTURE OF THE VESSEL FROM THE MARINA. VESSEL OWNERS OF OPERATORS WILL NOT BE BILLED FOR CHARGES UNLESS THEY HAVE, PRIOR TO ARRIVAL OR DEPARTURE, ESTABLISHED A CUSTOMER CREDIT RELATIONSHIP SATISFACTORY TO THE PORT AND THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SHILSHOLE BAY MARINA. 3 4. 5. A PENALTY CHARGE OF \$3.00 WILL BE MADE FOR VESSEL OWNERS OR OPERATORS WHO DO NOT REGISTER WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS OF FIRST ENTRY TO MARINA AT THE MARINA OFFICE. WHEN OFFICE IS CLOSED, ENVELOPES (IN A CONTAINER OUTSIDE THE OFFICE) (CONTINUED ON APE AVAILABLE FOR THIS PURPOSE AND CAN BE DEPOSITED IN THE LETTER SLOT IN THE PAGE No. 10) WALL.
