

RESOLUTION NO. ~~36~~ 37.

A resolution of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle providing for the rates to be charged for the use of the Port Ferry between the ferry landing near the foot of Yesler Way in the city of Seattle on the west shore of Lake Washington and the ferry landings at Medina and Bellevue on the east shore of Lake Washington.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE

As follows:

Section 1. That the following are the rates to be charged and which are hereby fixed for the use of the Port Ferry between the ferry landing near the foot of Yesler Way in the city of Seattle on the west shore of Lake Washington and the ferry landings at Medina and Bellevue on the east shore of Lake Washington:
