

RESOLUTION NO. 64

A RESOLUTION, making, determining, and deciding the amount of taxes to be levied upon the current assessment rolls to provide the necessary expenses of the Port of Seattle from January 1, 1913 to December 31, 1913, inclusive.

WHEREAS, the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle on the 29th day of August, 1912, adopted an estimate for the Port of Seattle from January 1, 1913, to December 31, 1913, inclusive, in detail as required by law, and thereafter made publication of the same and gave notice of the 7th day of October, 1912, as the date that any tax payers might appear to be heard in favor of or against any items shown in said estimate, and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing of said estimate was held in the office of the Port Commission in compliance with said notice in Seattle, King County, Washington, on the 7th day of October, 1912, at 2:00 P.M., no tax payers appearing to be heard in favor of or against the items in said proposed tax levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle:

Section 1. That the following be, and hereby is made, determined and decided to be the budget of the expense of the Port of Seattle, from January 1, 1913, to December 31, 1913, inclusive, to-wit:
