

RESOLUTION NO. 72

A Resolution of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, designating the places for voting at the general election to be held in the Port District on the second day of December, 1912, and fixing the time that said polls shall remain open, and providing for the giving of notice of such election.



Section 2. That the places for voting at said general election shall be kept open on said election day from the hour of eleven o'clock A.M. to the hour of eight o'clock P.M.


Section 3. That notice of such general election be given by publishing and posting in the manner provided by the statutes.
