

RESOLUTION NO. 92

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle providing for the calling for bids for the construction of the Central Waterfront Improvement.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of what is known as the Central Waterfront Improvement of the Port of Seattle have been duly prepared, which plans and specifications are divided into six subdivisions, as follows, each identified by a file-mark with appropriate title, and the signature of the Secretary of the Port Commission of date March 27, 1913:

- Subdivision I. Fill,
- Subdivision II. Substructure,
- Subdivision III. Superstructure,
- Subdivision IV. Roadways,
- Subdivision V. Motor Boat Floats,
- Subdivision VI. Warehouses.

AND WHEREAS, the said Port Commission is desirous at the present time of securing bids for the doing of the work involved in the said subdivisions II and III;

THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as follows:

Section 1. That said plans and specifications be, and the same are hereby adopted.

Section 2. That the Secretary of the Commission shall, and he is hereby authorized and directed to give such notice as is required by law, inviting sealed proposals for the construction of said subdivisions II and III, bids to be opened on the 10th day of April, 1913, at the hour of 1:30 o'clock P.M.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, this 27th day of March, 1913, and signed by its proper officers in open session on the same day in authentication of its passage.
