A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle providing for the calling for bids for the construction of the East Waterway Improvement.


WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of what is known as the East Waterway Improvement of the Port of Seattle have been prepared, which plans and specifications have been approved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle by Resolution No. 63.. dated October 30th, 1912;

AND WHEREAS, said Port Commission is desirous at the present time of securing bids for the doing of the work involved in said Subdivision IV of said plans and specifications entitled, "Superstructure;"


THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the Secretary of the Commission shall and he is hereby authorized and directed to give such notice as is required by law, inviting sealed proposals for the construction of said Subdivision IV, bids to be opened on the 14th day of May, 1913 at 1:30 o'clock P. M.
