

RESOLUTION NO. 100

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle providing for the calling for bids for the construction of the SALMON BAY IMPROVEMENT.


WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of what is known as the Salmon Bay Improvement of the Port of Seattle have been prepared, which plans and specifications have been approved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle by Resolution No. 73... dated November 7th, 1912.

AND WHEREAS, said Port Commission is desirous at the present time of securing bids for the doing of the work involved in said Subdivisions IV and V of said plans and specifications entitled, "Superstructure, roadway and Tracks" and "Marine Railway";

THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the Secretary of the Commission shall and he is hereby authorized to give such notice as is required by law, inviting sealed proposals for the construction of said Subdivisions IV and V, bids to be opened on the 15th day of May, 1913 at 1:30 o'clock P. M.
