

## RESOLUTION NO.114

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, designating the places for voting at the special election to be held in the Port District on the seventeenth day of June, 1913, and fixing the time that said polls shall remain open, and providing for the giving of notice of such election.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE, as follows:

Section 1. That the places for voting at the general election to be held in the Port District of the Port of Seattle on the seventeenth day of June, 1913, be, and the same are, fixed and designated as follows:
