A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, providing for the calling for bids for the installation of the light and power wiring system, Subdivision 4, Superstructures, roadways and tracks of the Salmon Bay Improvement.


WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of what is known as the Salmon Bay Improvement have been prepared, which plans and specifications have been approved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle by Resolution No. 76 dated November 7th, 1912;

AND WHEREAS, said Port Commission is desirous at the present time of securing bids for the doing ^{of a portion} of the work involved in said Subdivision 4 of said plans and specifications entitled, "Light and Power Wiring System";


THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the Secretary of the Commission shall and he is hereby authorized and directed to give such notice as is required by law, inviting sealed proposals for the construction of said ^{portion} Subdivision 4, bids to be opened on the 3rd day of July, 1913, at 1:30 o'clock P. M.
