IF SUCH MAXIMAIN CROSS EIGHT IS NOT FLYED BY OR FURSUANT TO LAW, THE DIRECTOR OF AVIATION IS AUTHORIZED TO ESTABLISH A RATE FOR THE SPECIFIC TYPE OF AIRCRAFT BY KNOWN FACTORS AND A REASONABLE INTERPRETATION.
