

RESOLUTION NO. 2310

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle
modifying certain rates, rules, and regulations
in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 100-A, F.M.C.-T
No. 2.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as
follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt
rules, regulations, and charges shown in:


Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 100-A, F.M.C.-T No. 2, 3rd revised
page No. 4, Participating Terminals,

copies of which are hereby annexed and made a part of this Resolution, said
rules, regulations, and charges to take effect on the dates thereon.

SECTION 2. All rules, regulations, and charges conflicting with
the provisions of the above listed page in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 100-A,
F.M.C.-T No. 2, WN.T. No. 25, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed to
file said schedule with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission
and the Federal Maritime Commission.
