

RESOLUTION NO. 2230

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle establishing certain rates as shown in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 100-A

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt as schedule and tariff rates, charges, rules and regulations for wharfage, car-loading and car unloading, and other services, the rates, rules and regulations as shown on:

in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 100-A, WN.T. No. 25, F.M.C. -T No. 2, copies of which are hereby annexed and made a part of this Resolution; said rates, rules and regulations to take effect on the dates shown on said revised pages.

SECTION 2. All charges, rates, rules and regulations conflicting with the provisions of the above enumerated pages in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 100-A, Wn.T. No. 25, F.M.C. -T No. 2, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Analyst has been directed to file said schedule of rates with the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission and Federal Maritime Commission.
