

RESOLUTION NO. 2244

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle
in remembrance of M. Stanley Erdahl.

WHEREAS, on Friday, October 21, 1966, the distinguished
career, both in public and private service, of M. Stanley Erdahl was brought
to a close by death; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tacoma, the State of Washington and the
entire Pacific Northwest have lost the benefit of a diligent and dedicated civic
leader; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Tacoma Commission has also lost the
counsel and advice stemming from Stanley Erdahl's many years experience
as member and chairman; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Port of Seattle Commission and
staff all have had the highest regard for Stanley Erdahl and his participation
in the development of the Puget Sound area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the undersigned
Commissioners, in behalf of the Port of Seattle, extend their condolences
to the surviving members of the family; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be
included in the minutes of the Port of Seattle Commission and a copy sent to
the family of Stanley Erdahl and to the Port of Tacoma Commission.

tures of the Commissioners voting in its favor and the seal of the Commis-
sion.
