

RESOLUTION NO. 2251

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle establishing certain rates as shown in Port of Seattle Military Tariff No. 1, naming rates, charges, rules and regulations for wharfage, carloading, car unloading and handling applying on U. S. military cargo at Port of Seattle operated terminals.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt as schedule and tariff rates, charges, rules and regulations for wharfage, carloading, car unloading, handling and other services as shown in:

Port of Seattle Military Tariff No. 1

SECTION 2. Adoption of the described tariff is in accordance with the provisions of Item No. 10250, Seattle Terminals Tariff 2-E, reading as follows:

Cargoes sponsored by the U. S. Government will be subject to contract rates quoted by the Port of Seattle upon request.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager has been directed to file said schedule of rates with the Military and other concerned Governmental Agencies.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 28th day of February, 1967, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the Seal of the Commission duly affixed.
