

RESOLUTION NO.150

RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle approving plans and specifications and providing for the calling for bids for the foundations of warehouse structures for the Central Waterfront Improvement.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of what is known as the Central Waterfront Improvement of the Port of Seattle have been prepared, which plans and specifications have been approved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle by Resolution No.92 dated March 27, 1913;

AND WHEREAS, said Port Commission is desirous at the present time of securing bids for the construction of warehouse foundations as provided in Subdivision VI of said plans and specifications,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE, as follows:

Section 1. That plans and specifications for the said foundations dated October 1, 1913, identified by file mark and by title as follows: "Amplification of plans and specifications of Central Waterfront Improvement warehouse foundations" be and are hereby adopted as an amplification of Subdivision VI of said Resolution No.92.

Sec. 2. That the Secretary of the Commission shall and he is hereby authorized and directed to give such notice as is required by law, inviting sealed proposals for the construction of warehouse foundations upon said plans and specifications provided by Resolution No.92 and amplified by this resolution and also upon alternative plans and specifications to be submitted by the bidder, bids to be opened on the 3rd day of November, 1913, at 1:30 o'clock P.M.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle on this 1st day of October, 1913, and signed in open session by its proper officers in authentication of its passage on the same day.
