

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle authorizing filing of application with the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce, United States of America, for a grant and/or loan under the terms of Public Law 89-136.

WHEREAS, under the terms of Public Law 89-136, the United States of America has authorized the making of grants and/or loans to public bodies and private or public non-profit organizations or associations to aid in financing the construction of specific public projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port of Seattle Commission:

1. That Robert W. Norquist, President of the Port of Seattle Commission, be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Port of Seattle with the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce for a grant and/or loan to aid in financing the construction of a five million bushel grain terminal facility to be located at Pier 86. Economic Development Administration aid is requested for filling, bulkheading, paving, construction of aprons and costs of site preparation.

2. That J. Eldon Ophelm, General Manager, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Economic Development Administration U. S. Department of Commerce, may reasonably request in connection with the application when it is herein authorized to be filed.
