

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle establishing certain rates as shown in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 2-E

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt as schedule and tariff rates, charges, rules and regulations for Bonded and U.S. Customs General Order Storage and other services, the rates, rules and regulations as shown on:

Original Page No. 55

in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 2-E, WN.T. No. 24, F.M.C.-T No. 1, copies of which are hereby annexed and made a part of this Resolution; said rates, rules and regulations to take effect on the date shown on said Original Page No. 55.

SECTION 2. All charges, rates, rules and regulations conflicting with the provisions of the above enumerated page in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 2-E, WN.T. No. 24, F.M.C.-T No. 1, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Analyst be and is hereby directed to file said schedule of rates with the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission and Federal Maritime Commission.
